### NEW WEBSITE OFFICIALY LAUNCHED!

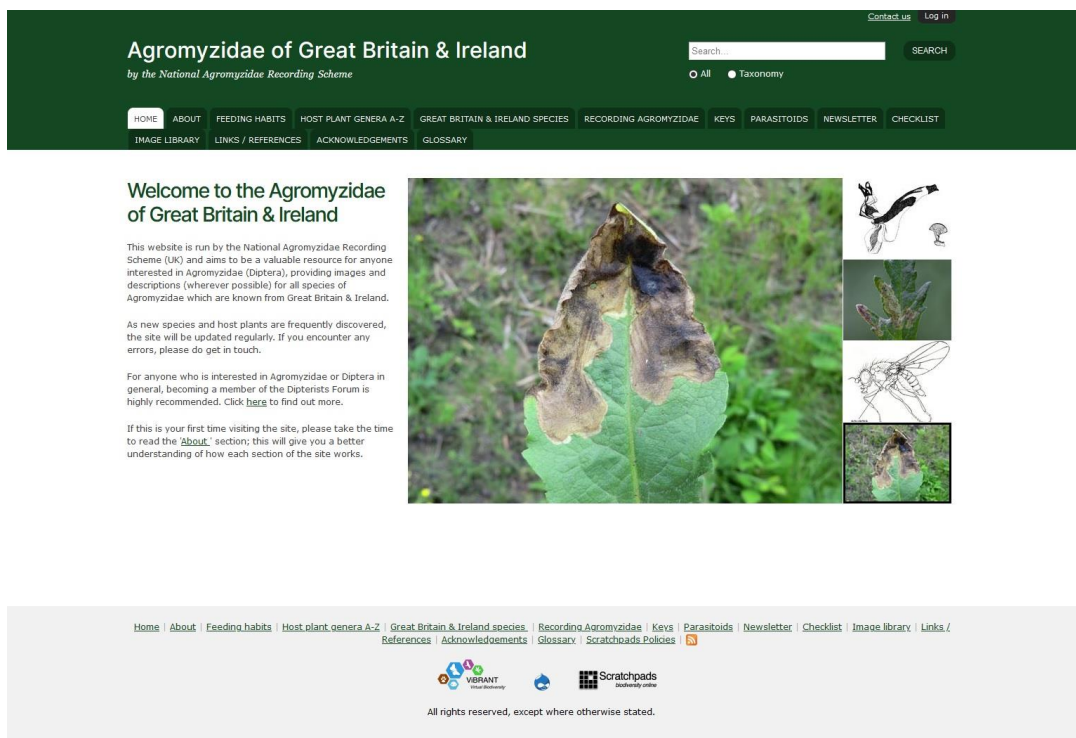
